SOUTHERN BANDIT race in the middle of pack, gained ground in the turn and had no final kick to overtake the front of the pack. DEVILISH WAYS race evenly throughout. MATTRESS MACK was void of early and lacked a late response. RARE WIND offered too lil too late. SORRYIAM showed good speed. LUCKY FAST failed to menace. DE RAIL was no factor. RICH SOUTHERN BOY was outrun and passed tiring rivals. COME ACROSS SHORTY was never a factor. A. P. ADOLPH was in close to the leaders at the quarter pole and steadily retreated after.
