BLUE PAC broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, widen the effort entering the turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole and was well clear while never threatened. NEON NAT chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, altered outside for the drive but could only gain the place. VIC O HONEY far back early, advanced inside, made a bid entering the drive and closed well late. LAURENT DU VAR went evenly. LORD AUBREY forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. PRINCE GO GO up close early from the inside, tired. MARKET CHARGER was no factor. HIGH DISTINCTION was no threat. MILLERS BOY had little interest. RUFFLED AGAIN was never close. AFTERNOONATWHITEYS showed little. IRISH BUCKET was off a step slow and outrun.
