CAPE SAN BLAS stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded and wore down rivals the final furlong. KILLING ME broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear advantage, remained clear entering the turn, held a clear margin at the eighth pole but could not last. WAITING ON HUNTER up close early from the inside, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. SUGAR BOWL DAY pressed the early pace from the outside but had nothing left for the drive. I'D BE A SECRET went evenly. MY SUGAR RAY was no factor. FLYING IDE was no threat. EVEN was always outrun.
