CAJUN D'ORO was well rated while setting the pace from the inside, drew off in mid stretch and was kept to task in the end. TREY J. was allowed to settled then rallied and saving ground on the far turn, was inside in the stretch, angled out to be two wide in late stretch and was gaining ground but was second best. TOO MUCH SAUCE was stalked the pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then came up empty in late stretch. GOOSEY was allowed to settled then was rank on the run down the backstretch, made a bid three wide on the far turn but came up empty in late stretch. GRACE'S BANDIT chased the early pace while racing three wide, made a bid on the far turn but faltered in the stretch drive. THUNDER BILL was allowed to settled while racing three wide on the backstretch then faltered in the stretch drive. TONY BOY was allowed to settled then was no factor. SOUTHOMO was unhurried early and was no factor. WAR DEAL showed little while trailing.
