SOLID SENDER was dueling for the lead while two wide while in hand, drew off in late stretch and was easily the winner while being taken in hand in deep stretch. SWEET ALICE BENBOW dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch but was clearly second best. STREAMING LIVE chased the early pace while three wide into the turn, raced evenly throughout. NITAP raced three wide on the turn then was evenly and no threat in the stretch. CASEY WONDERBOY was unhurried early and no menace. AVERY LYNN was inside and lacked a rally in the stretch. BOBBIELU was hard to load then trailed throughout.
