CHIEF JAY stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded when asked, gained the margin at the eighth pole and reported home with authority. MR. PORTER chased the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded and closed well late. BREAK UP outrun early, made a bid entering the turn and finished with good energy late. TOP CAT BOOGIE dueled from between foes early, held a forward position for the drive but had nothing left. PIRATE ISLAND dueled from the outside and tired. CLASSY DEELITES dueled from the inside and tired. GUSTAV BAY was no factor. HENRY'S TEDDYBEAR was no threat. ST. ARIAN forced the early pace and tired. TOO DIM had little interest. COTILE LAKE had a steady fade.
