EXCELL WITH ELLE close up, bid three wide entering the turn, gained the edge nearing mid stretch and moved clear late. BAYOU BEAUTY forwardly placed, bid outside GOLDIE RIO nearing the second turn, tried hard but was no match for the winner. GOLDIE RIO cleared to the rail entering the first turn, responded when collared around the second turn and then faltered once overtaken. PINKIES VALENTINE maintained an even position while off the rail. MISS CAJYN trailed for a half and then was no real threat. GO MISS BAG showed little. LUCAS POND was always back. TIFFANY CUT dropped back.
