STORMY SURGE steadied early, was steered to the rail approaching the turn, rallied late and passed tiring foes. SOUP R MARKET sprinted clear early, was overtaken by MT. REE TAH before the turn and while no match for the top two was game for the show. SPARKLING JACK never far back, could make little impact. MT. REE TAH hustled from the outside, got clear around the turn, was headed inside the furlong marker and then faltered. STIR THE SAUCE raced wide and lacked the needed finish. MELI'S CHOICE improved position. WHATEVER WILL BE tired. QUINT'S MALAGRA forwardly placed for a half, faded. CRUCIAL CLAY was outrun. CHELSI'S HIT raced green early and was no factor. HOURRA LARRY was always back.
