MOON DOLLY (GB) was unhurried while wide, steadied outside the fallen mare at the twelfth fence, rallied wide into the stretch to bid for command, started lugging in after the third-last fence, her rider switched to left-hand whip, drew even at the last fence and drew clear while continuing to lug in despite left-handed whipping. JELLYBERRY stalked the pace on the inside, gained command before the ninth fence, held a clear lead into the final turn, responded gamely when challenged and just missed in a long drive. DYNASKILL trailed for five fences, steadied and angled inside the fallen mare at the twelfth fence, rallied into the stretch but failed to sustain her bid. MISS CROWN was well placed on the inside, stepped on the fallen mare at the twelfth fence and gave way. FARAH T SALUTE held a clear early lead, hesitated before the second and third jumps, landing awkwardly and losing most of her lead at each jump, led to near the ninth fence, steadied after the twelfth fence, went wide and gave way. THE MANNER BORN was outrun, gave way and pulled up before the twelfth fence. LAIR raced early in the middle of the pack, moved closer after the first circuit, steadily advanced to challenge for command between horses at the twelfth fence and fell.
