Footnotes

GRINDING SPEED was unhurried while racing in the middle of the pack, rallied up the hill, improved his position approaching the far turn, challenged DAKOTA SLEW in the upper stretch and drew off after the last fence under steady urging. JOHN WYATT trailed to the top of the hill, rallied into the far turn and stayed on well. DAKOTA SLEW was unhurried early, rallied up the hill to gain command out of the hill, led a clear lead into the far turn, dueled with the winner to the last jump and tired. ATRIUM pressed the pace through the first circuit, challenged for the lead in the center of the course, hit the fence before the uphill, gained a short lead coming down the hill and then tired. MONSTALEUR rated through the first circuit, rallied up the hill to bid for the lead going down the hill but was soon done. EMBARRASSED quickly took command and increased his advantage, turned back a challenge from ATRIUM before the hill to gain a clear lead again, his saddle slipped at the top of the hill and his rider nearly fell off, jumped the remaining fences and finished the course. SGT. BART was well placed to the bottom of the hill and was pulled up thereafter. JOSHUA G. was well placed, weakened on the downhill and was pulled up.
