CLASS CLASSIC rated in the middle of the pack, steadily advanced on the outside on the backstretch the second time, rallied strongly on the final turn to duel over the final jump and drew off. BE GREAT rated near the back early, steadily advanced after eighth jumps, rallied into the stretch but couldn't catch the winner. DYNASKILL was never far back, stalked the pace to the final turn, rallied to duel for the lead into the upper stretch and then weakened. CLASS MARK quickly took command, took a long lead after the first circuit, led into the upper stretch and tired. GENERAL ROANOKE pressed the pace, couldn't match strides with CLASS MARK entering the second circuit and weakened on the final turn. SO AMAZING (IRE) trailed and was pulled up at the second-last jump. FINAL STRAW was outrun and was pulled up at the second-last jump. FIVE PINES had only brief speed and pulled up at the tenth jump. GREAT HALO trailed and was pulled up at the eighth jump. MOVING VIOLATION was pulled up after the first jump.
