**Footnotes**

WANTAN (ARG) was allowed to settle, made steady progress going down the backside for the final time, rallied in the top turn, dueled with PYNIFORMER over the last three jumps in the stretch then drew clear after the last. PYNIFORMER stalked pace got the lead briefly at the head of the stretch, dueled with the winner but was no match. DEALER BEWARE raced in the back, rallied in the top turn, was right there jumping the third last then flattened out. ALL TOGETHER was never far back contended until the second last but came up empty. OLD TIMER was through after a mile and passed tired rivals in the stretch. MASK AND WIG was in contention until the final then tired. EMBARRASSED took command from the beginning and stopped at the head of the stretch and was pulled up before the last jump. GRANTOR was never in contention and was pulled up before the last jump. JACK TWIST (NZ) raced evenly, lacked rally and was pulled up before the second last jump. COUPE DE VILLE had mild rally going down the backside for the final time then fell back and was pulled up after the third last jump. SGT. BART stalked pace for a mile and a half then weakened and was pulled up after the third last jump. CLASS CENTURY refused to start.
