Footnotes

DIABLO'S PEAK dueled wide in the early going the cleared rivals and was kept to task. J AND B'S NU IMAGE in touch then 4-wide into the stretch, came home willingly and proved second best. CRUMPET raced off the leaders, closed on the turn, split foes in early stretch and ended with a mild rally. SLOT HAPPY dueled 4-wide in the early going then gave way on the turn. BUCQUISTA was in a speed duel with a bunch, then tired in the drive. RAGING REDHEAD forced the pace in a duel between foes and 3-wide then weakened in the stretch. WINNER'S BID dueled for the lead from the inside through the turn then faded.
