Footnotes

CHRIS'S BAD BOY showed speed, dueled through the turn then edged clear a furlong out and drew off. VALID EDITION showed speed, dueled with the winner through the turn and into the stretch but was no match in the final furlong. GORDY'S OUR MAN raced midpack between rivals, closed three-wide in the stretch but failed to menace. DEPUTY CALL trailed early on the fourth path then rallied late five-wide. MARTY'S BOY was close early, chased along the rail on the turn then lacked a closing response. SWEETY'S BOY raced three-wide from well off the pace then lacked a rally. STRIKE M RED showed brief speed, dropped back nearing the turn and faded outside rivals.
