Footnotes

PARWOOD forced the early pace, dug in around the turn and was kept to task through the stretch. MONASHEE DANCER was squeezed early made a move around the turn, angled out top of stretch and was second best. AGAIN PLEASE was off the pace , moved inside on the turn and closed well. HONEST AL was well back, gained ground on the turn and finished well. TIMELESS TOMAHAWK dueled inside, backed off, no second effort. REGENT DANCER was back early had a mild rally and faltered in the stretch drive. JOUSTING PRINCE pressed pace from the gate, vied to the drive and weakened. NORTH OF SUPERIOR was back early, trailed and was no factor. UNGIVEN REASON was mid pack early, in the 4-path around the turn and was no threat.
