CALL TO SERVE was hustled early, took command on the turn and was much the best. MIS BELVEDERE stalked the early leader from the inside, moved to the four path at the top of the stretch and was second best. WILDA was off the pace, gained ground on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch was up for show. MMAMABULA was in mid pack and raced evenly from the inside on the turn but had no late kick. WEDDING PROMISE tracked the leader, chased on the turn and from the five path through the stretch leveled off. HAGGAT HALL showed no speed and was roused from the three path on the turn but from the seven path through the stretch was all out. NOT TONIGHT HONEY was off the pace and showed little in a dull effort. BACHELORETTE was in touch early but lost ground on the turn and from the six path through the stretch was empty.
