INSTANT APPEAL was hustled early, set the pace, had a clear lead in mid stretch and proved best. CANADIANNE WHISKEY was away alertly, stalked the leader and from the four path at the top of the stretch had a good effort. TO BOLDLY GO was in mid pack, raced evenly from the inside on the turn and finished well through the stretch. PURPLE SATCHEL was in touch and a factor from the three path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch lacked a late kick. BOLD DASH was back early and had a mild gain from the five path on the turn but from the eight path through the stretch had no impact. JAZZUNTA was in mid pack, roused from the three path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch evened out. OILVE OIL TOO was up close early but chased on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was outrun. FUTURE CUPID showed no speed and trailed the field on the turn while never a threat. MOONSHADE was off the pace, saved ground on the turn but was not a factor.
