SPEND TO SAVE was hustled away, factor from the three path on the turn and with the lead in mid stretch drew clear. RUN LIKE BELL was back early, raced from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was up for place. CHERRY RING POP stalked the leaders and was roused from the three path on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch was all out. MOLINARO KISS was away alertly, led on the turn and vied to mid stretch but gave way late. NEWTOWN GIRL was in touch and raced evenly from the inside on the turn but had no kick. DASH OF THE BEST was in mid field and saved ground on the turn but failed to fire. LORI'S COMING GREY had no speed, was hustled along on the turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch had no impact. SCOTTS RIVAL was bothered at the break, showed little and was not a factor. LAILA'S DREAM was in mid pack and hustled on the turn but faded through the stretch. LISA FELICIA was off the pace and showed nothing while never a threat.
