LAZY MOON stumbled at the start, moved quickly to join the front runner and moved away in midstretch, continued to widen under a drive. MURPH'S STAR was close up, made a bid but was no match for the winner. IRON ANCHOR moved off to the lead in hand, was headed shortly out of the gate, remained under pressure, got tired and gave way. FOREIGN CURRENCY was allowed to settle but lack a rally. ROSANA'S INTENTION was well placed behind the leader down the backstretch, angled out on the turn and went 8 wide, and failed to menace. KRYSAMS stalked the pace was carried out on the turn and lacked a late response. SUMMA SAMARA was unhurried early, made a bid on the rail, faltered and was eased.
