KINSHASA'S PARADIS forced pace from the gate, vied on the turn, led top of the stretch and prevailed. MELODY OF GOLD showed speed from the gate, forced pace on the turn and was outfinished. FLEET STORM was in touch, gain on the turn and had a good finish. INTUITION MAGIC was off the pace, inside on the turn and had a good effort to the wire. SUNDAY PRINCE was mid pack between foes and finished evenly. CUSACK broke awkwardly, was in the five path on the turn and passed tired foes. SEA PLEASURE was unhurried early, never close in a dull effort. CALEDON CAT was off the pace, saved ground on the turn and was no factor.
