### Footnotes

DISBELIEF settled on the inside early, angled out into the far turn, circled foes and took on the front runner in the drive the drew off under strong handling. GALAXY had inside speed to show the way, vied into the far turn, held the lead into the stretch then finished off a solid try while unable to match the winner in the late going. WADEKAR never far back and 3-wide while keeping in the game, bid on the far turn, and then finished willingly. HENNESY MOON pressed the pace for six, then weakened on the inside in the drive. MY PAL WILLIAM in touch and on the outside, was in the game into the far turn but had no finish. WINGED OVER raced in mid pack and lacked the needed bid. FAYGO DANCING HOME tracked the leaders with an inside trip then tired. SANDSPIT broke in the air and was never a serious factor. WHISKEY SPECIAL in mid pack then four wide and in the hunt on the far turn, faded.
