Footnotes

SHER'S EXPECTATION showed speed, dueled from the inside on the turn and with a clear lead in mid stretch proved best. COMEONCOMEONCOMEON was off the pace, had a mild gain on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch finished well. CHERRY RING POP dueled early and vied for the lead on the turn but from the three path through the stretch leveled off late. SHE IS A KUTIE was in mid field and raced evenly from the three path on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had no late kick inside. SILENT FOREST stumbled at the start, was hustled early and a factor on the turn but weakened. BACHELORETTE was in mid pack and saved ground on the turn but lacked a late response. MARGAREE MISS had no speed and was hustled along on the turn in a dull effort. LORI'S COMING GREY trailed the field, showed nothing and was outdistanced.
