Footnotes

SKY HALO showed speed, had the lead on the turn and from the four path through the stretch fought gamely for the win. WINLOC'S GAL was up close, a factor from the inside on the turn and vied through the stretch but was outfinished. PRETTY PRETTY GIRL was away alertly and raced evenly from the inside on the turn in a good effort. HEREISTHERING had no speed and saved ground on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch needed more. WASTED was off slow and hustled along on the turn but from the five path through the stretch evened out. SOAR was back early and roused from the three path on the turn but lacked a late kick on the inside through the stretch. BELIEVE THE FOX was off the pace and hustled from the three path on the turn but from the seven path through the stretch had no impact. STILL SHARP was unhurried and saved ground on the turn but was never a threat. TREE LO trailed the field, showed nothing and was eased through the stretch.
