MECKE B KING was in touch, moved up from the three path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch proved best. ITSWHATWELIVEFORE was in mid field, roused on the turn and finished well to get up for place. EXCALIBUR was hustled early, dueled from the inside on the turn and vied to mid stretch but gave way late. MUDDER AT THE BAR was unhurried early, hustled along from the four path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch was all out. POINT TUPPER had no speed and was roused from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch needed more. R SHINING HOPE stalked the pace, was a factor from the outside on the turn but from the four path through the stretch had nothing left. GALAXY was off the pace, trailed the field on the turn and had no impact. ARMORED showed speed but chased from the inside on the turn and came up empty. DEPUTY LOR was in mid pack but showed little and was outrun.
