### Footnotes

MONTROSE AVENUE was unhurried early, moved up from between foes on the turn and from the six path through the stretch was up in time. CLASSIC MORGEY showed no speed, was hustled along from the five path on the turn and from the seven path through the stretch was up for place. ZENKO pressed the pace, was a factor from between foes on the turn and from the four path through the stretch had a good effort. IT'S TIME BEAR stalked the leader and was roused from the three path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch leveled off. GRANT'S LOVE was hustled early and saved ground on the turn but finished evenly. WHOLELOTTABOURBON showed speed and set a pressured pace but weakened in upper stretch. PRESSING ISSUE was in mid field and raced evenly from the four path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch had no impact. EXPLOSIVE GREEK was in mid pack but lost ground on the turn in a dull effort. RAPIDE ONE was off slow and trailed the field while not a factor.
