Footnotes

GENERAL DEPUTY tracked the speed battle from off the rail, was in the 5-path for the drive, fired down the lane and cleared all rivals in the final sixteenth. BAYBERG WARRIOR bumped and steadied in the early going, was between foes on the turn and wide for the stretch bid, then flew home and got up for the place in a solid recovery run. BAJAN PRIDE dueled inside and went head and head into the stretch, was game in the drive but could not match the first two late. CHAROWSKI stalked the speed battle in a good trip from the inside, bid in the drive but was outkicked. TRAJECTORY O SOUTH dueled for the lead and was 3-wide into the stretch then tired in the final furlong. FEARLESS BUZZ had an even effort from mid field. JUDITHS TRAIL close up in the early going, saved ground into the stretch then lacked the needed kick. BANKER ADAM was wide through the turn then did not menace. HENNESY MOON broke poorly, trailed early and did not threaten. DANGEROUS CROSSING bumped early, was never a factor. I'M A ROBBER was well back and never close. SON OF COMPADRE had speed between foes then faltered turning for home and faded.
