REGAL 'N BOLD gained ground and bid 4-wide on the turn, went after the front runner in the drive and got to that one in the late stages. ALITTLEBITGRUMPY just off the pace of the leader, bid inside on the turn, took command into the final furlong then was caught late. LOW KEY AFFAIR came from the trailing spot to be wide for the stretch run then had a belated kick. PASSIONATE BIRD had an inside trip, saved ground then put in a mild rail bid. PROSPECTIVE GAL off the early pace, was outside of foe and just off the rail for the drive then lacked the needed rally. MYWAY WEST bumped at the break, raced wide while up on the pace then weakened in the drive. CALL ME SUE had speed to show the way, opened a gap, led on the turn and then faltered.
