STARBUCK RON stalked the leader, was a factor between foes on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was outgunned. GUNS AND BUTTER set the pace, was pressured on the turn and vied through the stretch but gave way late. COUNT FLOYD showed no speed, had a mild gain from the four path on the turn and from five path through the stretch was willingly. MOON CAT trailed the field and from the five path had a belated rally through the stretch. MOBIL DREAMER was up close, had a bid from the three path on the turn and from the five path faded in the drive. O B THE BEST was unhurried, raced evenly on the turn and failed to fire. NEED YOU NOW was off the pace and roused from the inside on the turn but had no response.
