WHOS HOT NOW stalked the leader, pressed the pace on the far turn and with a bid from the three path through the stretch proved best. SKIP THE NIGHT was away alertly, set the pace, dueled from the inside on the far turn and fought gamely in defeat. WITH ALL DILIGENCE was up close, a factor on the far turn and from the four path through the stretch was the best of the rest. CINEMA SHOW was unhurried early and hustled along from the three path on the far turn but lacked a rally. SEASIDE VIEW had no speed and was roused from between foes on the far turn in a dull effort. LA GRAN EMMA was off the pace and saved ground on the far turn but was never in contention.
