HIGHS AND LOWS was in touch, moved up from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch forged clear. CALL TO SERVE was hustled early, had the lead on the turn and dueled in upper stretch but was outfinished. JOKING FEMME was unhurried early and saved ground on the turn but lacked a serious bid. DREAM CRUSADER was off the pace and roused from between foes on the turn but from the five path through the stretch had no impact. LANGFANN was off slow, had a mild gain from the four path on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had no impact. BODACIA was in range and hustled along from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch leveled off. HEY BIG TIME was up close but chased on the turn and tired in upper stretch. GUARANTEED ISSUE was away alertly but dropped back on the turn and was not a factor.
