Footnotes

BUFFALO STORM was in mid field, moved up on the turn and with the lead from the three path at the top of the stretch was much the best. YOU WOOD was unhurried early and gained ground on the turn but was no match for the winner through the stretch. SENOR UNO was up close and a factor on the turn but from the four path through the stretch finished evenly. GOOD TO SEE YOU set the pace and had the lead on the turn but was headed at the top of the stretch and gave way. BROMPTON ROAD was in touch and roused from the three path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch had no finish. BOLD BOSS was in range and saved ground on the turn but had no impact. FLANAGAN STATION was off the pace and hustled along from the four path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch had a dull effort. BOO BOO'S LOVE had no speed and showed nothing while never a threat. ANNE'S ALPHA BET was in mid pack early but dropped back on the turn and was outrun.
