DISBELIEF came from well off the pace to be wide on the turn and gaining, bid 6-wide into the stretch and came home with a strong wide rally to go clear late. MY PAL WILLIAM stalked the leaders in a good trip then bid 3-wide turning for home, was in the tussle to the wire but outdone in the late going. PLEASANT HALL gained ground from mid pack, was going well into the stretch while outside of foes then finished with good energy. ANGEL'S WISDOM stalked the leaders from off the rail, bid between rivals turning for home, looked a danger but was outfinished in the late going. DASHING MONTY came from well back to saved ground into the stretch, bid up the rail and finished willingly. SMILING JORDAN in striking distance, was a factor turning for home but outkicked in the drive. WILDFORYOU dueled outside of foes and took the battle into mid stretch before weakening. RED ROCK NATIVE was off the pace and did not fire. PICADOR KAT had inside speed to duel through the turn then gave way in the drive. IRISH DAVE was never close in a trailing effort.
