DEPUTY LOR was in touch, three path on the backstretch, vied on the turn, took the lead top of the stretch and was clear to the wire. RED LAKE GOLD stalked the leader on the backstretch, had a bid on the inside on the turn and was out kicked to be second best. MALIBU MONSTER trailed early, hustled on the far turn, angle out at the top of the stretch and rallied late. LAZYLOU CARSON was off the pace, gained ground on the far turn, good position at the top of the stretch and flattened out. JOEY'S SMOKIN GUN showed early speed, led to the half mile pole and gave way.
