SERGEANT MATT stalked the leader, had a rally on the turn, bid in the stretch and proved best. LONE ENDEAVOR showed speed, was in hand on the turn, had the lead till deep stretch and was outfinished. VIKRANT was off the pace, gained ground on the turn and closed willingly on the inside. SEA PLEASURE broke awkwardly, trailed and had a mild stretch rally. BRIGHT N GOLDEN was well back, moved up on the turn, was in the six path through the stretch with no response. EXPLOSIVE GREEK was in touch, chased leaders on the turn and needed more. SHPEEN raced mid pack, had a mild bid on the turn and faded in the drive.
