GALAXY settled off the pace and off the rail, was in the five path turning for home and outside of foes then came on home with a willing effort to best the rest. HENNESY MOON had speed and a slim off the rail lead, was pressured into the far turn, kept it going then was no match for the winner and gave way but held the show spot. GALLOP POLE came from off the pace with a mild three path run but it was not enough. WONNESOMORE pressed the pace while inside into the far turn then backed off and faded. WINGED OVER trailed early and failed to menace. SAUCY VINNY was off the pace throughout and not a factor. SHORT MEMORY pressed from the outside, was a factor for six, then faded.
