KAIN'S CITY stalked the early leader, took the lead early on the backstretch, was pressed at the top of the stretch and was a clear winner. SKIP THE NIGHT was forwardly placed early, gained on the far turn, pressed the winner at the top of the stretch and was second best. WAKE UP TIGER was well back, in the six path on the far turn and closed willingly in the drive. RICH DESTINY was unhurried early, gained ground between foes on the turn and faded in the stretch. DANCINGTHENITEAWAY was mid pack, roused on the far turn and tired inside through the stretch. ANITACRUISE was off the pace, had a mild bid on the far turn and flattened out. OTTY OTTY CATTY was well back, showed nothing and was never a factor. ONE FOR BARB broke alertly, pressed the leader for a half mile, dropped back on the far turn and was empty in the stretch.
