VALID VISA had speed from the outside, was hustled along from the three path on the turn and with the lead from the four path at the top of the stretch prevailed. BEEJAYKAY was in touch and had a good position on the turn but from the five path through the stretch was second best. L. T.'S GIRL was up close and vied from between foes on the turn but leveled off late. ALKES GAL was in range and raced evenly from the four path on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had no impact. YOU'VE BEEN PLAYED was hustled early and chased from the inside on the turn but had nothing left.
