HASTIE BECKY hustled to the early lead, dueled into the turn and was headed then rebid midturn, dueled to the top of the stretch and shook clear then held sway under a drive. CARELESS BID stalked the pace, moved off the rail and three-wide chasing the leader out of the turn, angled back in to the rail with a sixteenth to run and was all out to be best of the rest. REGAL QUILLO stalked the pace, was outrun on the turn then finished evenly. ROSE DARLING dueled on the backstretch and shook clear briefly early turn, entertained a challenged midturn but could not match strides and tired in the stretch. CHINA NIGHTS stalked the pace three-wide, faded on the turn and lacked a closing response. COLLEGE MISS saved ground but lacked a rally. FREDINA raced three-wide and lacked a rally.
