Footnotes

QUITE BY CHANCE was on the outside of foes and off the early pace, continued wide through the turn then rallied strong from the outside through the stretch while finding her best stride late. TOUGH RAMBLER off the pace and then saving ground into the stretch, made a good inside run in the drive but was outfinished. REGAL VICTORIA had early speed to hook others in a 3-wide duel, backed off into the turn, stalked then came again between foes and finished well. VATRENA RAKETA dueled from the outset and stayed in the battle into mid stretch then faltered. SAUCY VIXEN stalked the speed duel from off the rail, bid in the stretch run then evened out. WINGS OF POWER off the early pace and between foes, lacked any serious bid. CLASSIC GRATA had inside speed to duel through the turn then faded.
