CACOUNA set the pace, in hand on the turn, was roused early in the stretch and prevailed to the wire. HEAR THE BEAT stalked outside early, was hustled up on the turn, had a striking position at the top of the stretch but was no match late. VIKRANT took back early, gained ground on the turn, five path in the stretch and finished well. KINSHASA'S PARADIS was mid pack, had a bid between foes on the turn and was outfinished in the drive. WILD DIAMOND was in touch, chased on the turn and weakened. SLICE OF GLORY was unhurried, three path on the turn and lacked a rally. BABY BEAR was off the pace, had a mild gain on the turn and flattened out. PHILLY FRENZY was up close early, lacked room on the turn and had no finish. ONE MORE DAY trailed, failed to fire and was never a threat. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF PHILLY FRENZY AGAINST KINSHASA'S PARADIS AND BABY BEAR FOR INTERFERENCE INTO THE FAR TURN WERE NOT ALLOWED.
