**Footnotes**

STORMIN HOT showed speed from the inside, had the lead on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch was kept to task. TRUE DESTINY was in touch, had a mild gain from the inside on the turn and with a bid from the four path at the top of the stretch had a good effort. DERAILED was away alertly and a factor on the turn but from the six path through the stretch had no late kick. INSPIRED FOX was squeezed back at the start, saved ground on the turn and passed tired foes. ON ABBEY ROAD had no speed, showed little and had no impact. TROUBADOR SONG stalked the early leaders but chased on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was empty.
