ROMAN ROMANCE stalked the pace,moved off the rail late backstretch and was roused three-wide on the turn, gained steadily then swept to the lead with a furlong to run and held sway under a drive. BOUREE was unhurried between rivals, closed late on the turn and finished willingly but was clearly second best. SLIPPER SLEW showed speed, dueled to the 1/2 mile pole and drew clear, had command to upper stretch, was no match for the winner and tired. CLASSY PICKUP saved ground then hung in the stretch. TOUGH RAMBLER was well back early, raced three-wide, was roused on the turn then loomed up at the head of the stretch but hung. PROSPECTIVE GAL showed speed, had command to the 1/2 mile pole, was headed and chased after SLIPPER SLEW on the turn then tired.
