DECADENT DASH had inside speed to vie for the lead, dueled through the turn and into deep stretch then was full out to prevail. CASE OF PRIDE had speed to duel for the lead while outside of rival, kept in that tussle throughout then was bested at the wire. SONG OR PSALM in mid pack, angled out for the drive then angled in again and put in a strong late inside try but not in time. YUMEKO stalked the pace duel and kept in contact through the turn then put in a wide try in the drive and finished off a solid effort. KIRLAN in mid pack, was inside for the stretch run but did not have enough. STRAIGHT EXCHANGE came from off the pace to put in a mild off the rail gain but needed more. ELORA broke tardily then rushed up into the action to be in the hunt on the turn then had no stretch bid. GROMMET was well back and did not threaten. FEDELISIMA backed away from mid pack and was never a menace. WHATSTHECODE was pulled up and did not finish.
