HISAKI chased the speed from the inside and kept contact turning for home then had to settle for 2nd best. WILDCAT PRINCE raced evenly from mid pack and then lacked a stretch kick. WORTH A PUNT stalked the leader early, backed off from off the rail and faded. LONESOME CHEROKEE trailed in a dull try.
