### Footnotes

EXCALIBUR had speed to open a short gap early, was pressured outside into the turn, vied inside into mid stretch then drew clear while being kept to task. OUTOFTHEDEPHTS made an early move between foes to be outside of leader and haunting that one through the turn and into the stretch then was outfinished and settled for best of the rest. KWIK COSTA tracked the two leaders from off the rail, stayed in the hunt into the stretch then lacked a final kick. BUDDHA N' SMART bumped rival at the break, chased inside and was tracking into the stretch while inside of rival, left the rail for the drive but lacked the needed bid. ITSWHATWELIVEFORE bumped and bothered at the break, trailed the field before passing a tired one. ARMORED kept in touch into the stretch then failed to fire and ended up trailing the field home.
