YES IT'S RED set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn and widened under light handling. CRIMSON SPIRE was off the pace, roused from the inside on the turn and was up place. SILVER SHASA stalked the leaders and raced evenly on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch needed more. DRAGON WAVE was off slow and hustled along on the turn but from the five path through the stretch leveled off. NICOLANA was up close and had a good position on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch flattened out. PLEASURE TO PLEASURE had no speed, showed little and failed to fire. FUTURE CUPID was in touch early but chased on the turn and came up empty.
