CAPTAIN CHRIS showed speed, set the pace and with mild pressure at the top of the stretch prevailed. PLAYA NEGRA was away alertly, settled off the leader and was a factor from the four path at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner. DISBELIEF was unhurried early and hustled along from the three path on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch finished evenly. KINNAIRD was in touch and roused from the inside on the far turn but lacked a late response. GALAXY was well back and showed little while not a factor. POINT TUPPER was in mid pack and saved ground on the far turn but was outrun. MT. FUGI was off the pace, showed nothing and was pulled up in mid stretch.
