**Footnotes**

TROUBLE TODAY was back early, lacked room on the backstretch, had a good position at the top of the stretch and closed willingly. BUCK CASH was unhurried early, gained ground on the turn, five wide at the top of the stretch and rallied outside. JIMMY THE LINK was mid pack, saved ground on the turn, had a bid at the top of the stretch and closed between rivals. SUFFONCIFIED set a pressured pace, had a clear lead at the eighth pole and leveled off. YAMANA trailed, gained ground on the turn, angled out mid stretch in a good effort. STRETCHDRIVE stalked the leaders, chased on the turn and tired in the drive. POETIC CAT pressed the pace, vied in the three path through the stretch and gave way. PERFECT STUDENT was in range, four path turn to six path in the stretch and had no response. IRATE was in mid pack, had a mild gain on the turn, seven path at the top of the stretch and had no impact. DAVE'S RESURRECTION was off the pace, raced between rivals on the turn in a dull effort.
