**Footnotes**

DEVIL IN WILLIE was in mid pack, had a mild gain from the inside on the turn, closed willingly through the stretch and fought gamely for the win. BITING HUMOUR was in range, raced evenly from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch just missed. DURLINGVILLE stalked the leader, was a factor on the turn and vied from the five path at the top of the stretch but was outfinished. DOUBLE DUEL showed speed, had a clear lead on the turn, was pressured from the four path through the stretch and weakened. ULTERIOR MOTIVE was in hand early and hustled along from the inside on the turn but had no response. BULLET BOY was back early and had a mild gain on the turn but leveled off in the stretch. VEZEAU BEACH had no speed, raced evenly from the five path on the turn and passed tired foes in the stretch. JENPEG was in touch and lost ground on the turn in a dull effort. SIR H C EXCELLENT was off the pace, chased hard from the three path on the turn but was not a factor.
