WIRY WILLIE stalked the pace from the three path, drew even with FLYING TABRIZ at the quarter pole, dueled briefly, drew off and was all out at the finish. LA PRINCESSE JOLIE was taken back at the start, launched a rally four wide and was gaining. FLYING TABRIZ set the pace inside under pressure, drew off around the turn, was headed again, dueled with that one and gave way grudgingly. CULTURAL SHOCK reared at the start, was allowed to settle into stride on the inside but lacked a late response. LET'S BOOGIE failed to menace. SONG OR PSALM pressed the pace in the early stages, was through after a half mile and faded.
